

USSR Mechanized Infantry Platoon 1960-70

Consists of 4 BTR-60 APCs. Infantry consists of a HQ section and 3 squads of infantry.

Each squad consisted of 8-9 men. These can be represented by a rifle team, a RPG team and a PKM LMG team. HQ command section could contain a tripod-PK (GPMG) MG. One scout element could come out of the HQ section and another one self generated from the other squads in an advance.

A company consisted of three such platoons plus a company heavy weapons section.



USSR Mechanized Infantry Platoon 1980-90

Consists of 3 BMP-3 IFVs. Infantry consists of a HQ section and 3 squads of infantry.

Each squad consisted of 8-9 men. These were broken down into two rifle teams each with intrinsic RPK or later RPK-74 SAW. Included with each team are 1-3 rounds of RPG-16 or RPG.

The platoon received 2 more AT missiles. These were either the sagger or the AT-4.



Early 1990s the AT-4 became the standard anti-tank missile of the platoon.
